Submit **outstanding** college or university transcripts for any college course work you may have completed while in high school or since your high school graduation. Ask your college or university to submit an official transcript to our Admissions and Records Office for evaluation. Print out and complete the **Medical History Questionnaire form**. Send your completed form along with a copy of your immunization record to the Birkam Health Center, Ferris State University, 1019 Campus Drive, Big Rapids, MI 49307-2280. Submit the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** after **Jan. 1.** The financial aid office must have access to a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You must complete a FAFSA on line and indicate that you are considering attendance at Ferris. *To check for more information on Financial Aid, please contact: (231) 591-2110.*



Respond to the orientation mailings.
