### **Contest Rules**

#### Contestants must:

- be enrolled in a secondary welding course.
- be sponsored and accompanied by a teacher, instructor, or assistant.
- complete and pass the written safety test with a 90% score or better.
- behave in a safe and reasonable manner.
- respect all people involved in the competition.
- perform all welds in the manner described in the weldment description sheet.
- online registration with payment will begin February 27, 2024, and end April 5, 2024
- bring all safety equipment and tools needed to compete in this competition.
- each high school/technical center may enter only one competitor in each of the five (5) welding categories.

#### Also:

- 1. Input from sponsoring representative, once the competition begins, will not be allowed.
- 2. A \$25.00 per competitor registration fee is required. This payment is required at time of registration beginning February 27, 2024. No payments will be received the day of or after the competition. There is no charge for one instructor. If you bring an additional instructor/assistant, there is a \$25 charge. **Upon receipt of your registration, you will receive confirmation of registration, sample weldment drawings, and safety data (on or around April 5, 2024).**
