The CMU Promise, for new and transfer undergrad students, is one unchanging tuition rate for up to five years. In addition to fixing the cost of tuition, the CMU Promise eliminates all former mandatory fees. The CMU Promise also guarantees that the room and board rate for residence halls will not increase for two years from the date of admission to CMU. See <http://www.cmich.edu/tuitionguarantee/> for additional information on The CMU Promise Guaranteed Tuition Plan. For graduate students, an additional \$12/credit hour is assessed for most Physical Therapy courses.

² **EMU** – A General Education Program Fee of \$13.00 per credit hour is assessed on each 100 level course in Mathematics, Communications, English, and Science. All Military Science courses are assessed a \$10.00 per credit hour fee. Program fees are assessed for 300-499 course level courses at the following rates: Foreign Language = \$37.00 per credit hour.
