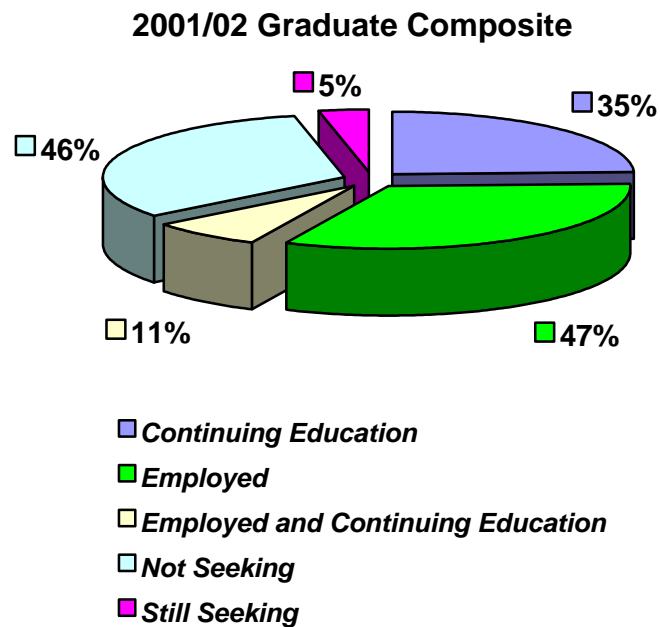

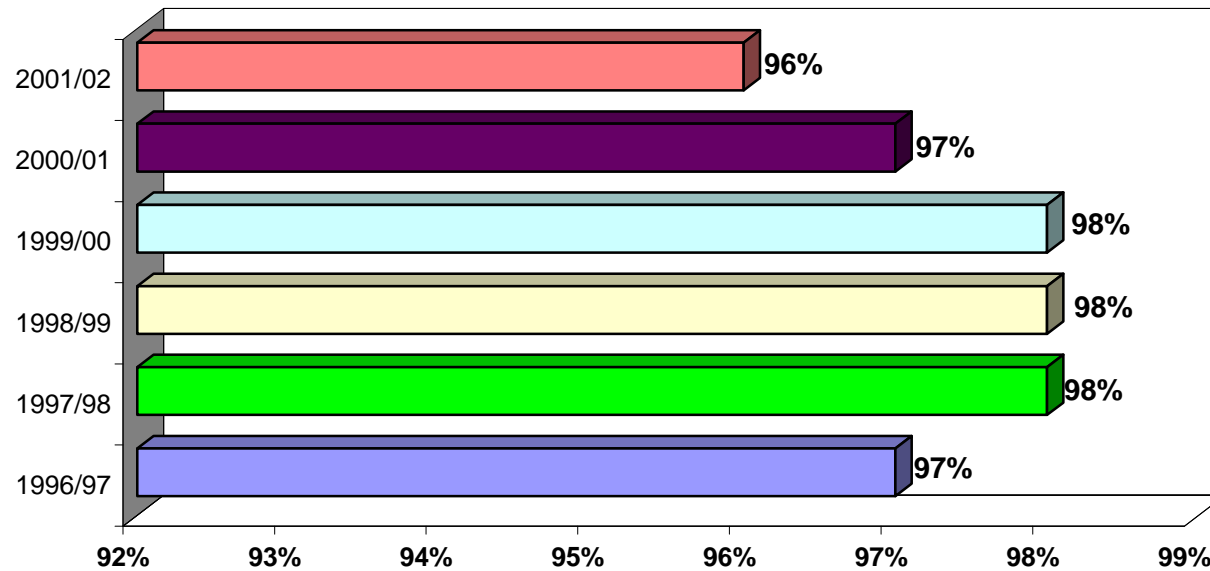
## 2001/2002 Graduate Follow-Up Survey - Overall Results



*Note: 90% of Graduates who are employed are employed in their field of study. For those continuing their education, 21% of those earning an Associates Degree move directly into a Bachelors program, while 6% move directly from a Bachelors to a Graduate Program.*

*Note: Respondents included here include those who are employed, or continuing their education full-time. Placement rates and salaries were slightly lower overall for the 2001/02 graduates, but perhaps less dramatic than was anticipated. According to the Fall 2002 NACE Occupational Study, the economy was sluggish and unwelcoming for graduates. Some graduates opted to pursue part-time and temporary work as the search for full-time employment remained difficult.*
