

Vehicle Registration & Parking
Be Informed! Did you know?

- *Did you know* that the Campus Police are open 24 hours per day/7 days per week? A temporary and/or guest permit can be obtained 24 hours per day. Student will be issued a temporary permit valid until noon of the next business day to get a valid permit.
- *Did you know* that anyone parking on University property must display a valid parking permit? That includes all guests to the University, except those who pay to park at a meter!
- *Did you know* you cannot park at a meter or in a commuter or faculty/staff lot overnight?
- *Did you know* if you have a residence hall or apartment parking permit you may only park in your assigned lot on campus during the day Monday through Friday or pay to park at a meter? After 5:00 P.M. you may park in a commuter or faculty/staff lot until 2:00 A.M.
- *Did you know* if you park at a meter you must pay the meter fee? After 5:00 P.M. meters are free, except at the Rock where they are enforced until 8:00 P.M. No parking at meters after 2:00 A.M.
- *Did you know* you cannot park a trailer on campus?
- *Did you know* you cannot leave a disabled vehicle on campus?
- *Did you know* that you can exchange your permit for \$1.00, if you bring a different vehicle to campus or get your windshield replace, by returning your old permit for exchange? **If you do not return your old permit it is \$100 to get a new permit.**
- *Did you know* when your tickets are transferred to your student account they are still considered "unpaid" until the amount has been paid in full either on your student account or in our office?
- *Did you know* all motorcycles or mopeds must be registered to park on campus? Motorcycles or mopeds may not be parked at a bicycle rack.
- *Did you know* parking decals must be fully affixed with their own adhesive to the windshield, lower right hand corner (passenger side of vehicle)?
- *Did you know* on FSU campus all legal parking spaces are marked with yellow lines, even along curbs where parking is allowed? **No yellow lines, you are in violation!**
- *Did you know* you have a 5 days grace period to pay/appeal your ticket before it is assessed a \$5.00 late fee?
- *Did you know* the only parking allowed after 2:00 A.M. is in your assigned residence hall or apartment lot, except at the FLITE lot (Lot 27) with a proper parking permit issued by library staff?
- *Did you know* altering a parking permit is a civil infraction? A ticket will be issued with a court appearance! Parking privileges may be suspended or revoked.
- *Did you know* if your permit is damaged in any way, you must exchange if for a new permit? A ticket will be issued for unlawful display if not replaced.
- *Did you know* it is your responsibility to know where you can park legally on campus? Any questions, please call 591-5000, 24 hours per day.
- *Did you know* there are 15 commuter lots across campus? If you cannot find a space in one commuter lot you need to move on to the next one? *Did you know* that Lots 19 and 28 are less than 10 minutes to your class?
- *Did you know* when you come into our office for any type of permit you must bring in your current vehicle registration and driver's license?
- *Did you know* when you appeal a parking ticket you must post a bond in the amount of the ticket and fill out an appeal form?
- *Did you know* that the Appeals Committee is made up with fellow students, who do not work for Campus Police?
- *Did you know* there are 2 drop boxes to pay your ticket? One in the main lobby of the Campus Police Office and one near the parking lot on the west side of West Commons (Campus Police) building.
