SUBPART 7-2 STATEMENT OF EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN EDUCATION AND SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC

- **Sec. 7-201.** Equal Opportunity in Education. This policy applies to each and every phase of educational programs, services and benefits, including recruitment, applications, admissions, enrollment, counseling and guidance, financial assistance, degree requirements, athletics, student life and other activities.
- **Sec. 7-202.** Equal Opportunity in Services to the Public. The University reaffirms its policy of providing social, cultural and other services, consistent with its mission, in a manner that does not discriminate with respect to members of the public in any way which violates the University's Policy on Non-Discrimination. This policy applies to each and every phase of all services to the public conducted by the University, or by University-sanctioned organizations, or at facilities under the control of the University.
- **Sec. 7-203.** Reporting Violations. Violations of this Subpart shall be reported to the Office of Equal Opportunity, appropriate Vice President or Dean, or other appropriate University officials.
