EMU – Program fees are assessed for 300-499 course levels at the following rates: Education, Arts, Humanities, & Social Sciences = \$30/cr. hr. Science (Biol, Chem, Comp. Sci., Math, Phys. Astronomy), Business (all), and Technology, Health Sciences, HPHP, Social Work = \$35/cr. hr. Nursing = \$60/cr. hr. All other courses (not covered above) = \$30/cr.hr. for UG. Online course fees are \$62.00/cr.hr.for all online courses. There is a Student Teaching fee of \$185.00 per class and New Student fee of 200. All General Fee and part of Program Fee have been rolling into Tuition Fee.

²GVSU - An additional \$27/cr. is assessed for International Studies, and Honors (course 200 level & above). An additional \$32/cr. is assessed for Dept Visual and Media Arts (Art, Photography, Film and Video), Dept of Music, Dance and Theatre, School of Computing, Allied Health, Health Information Management, Occupational Safety & Health, and Therapeutic Recreation. An additional \$37/cr. is assessed for Medical Lab Science, Nursing (courses 200 level & above), Radiologic and Imaging Sciences, and Speech and Language Pathology (200 level and above). Paramedic Technology Program – The program fee for the paramedic technology program is \$30 per credit hour. These fees support higher program costs related to clinical and laboratory courses and equipment. The Program Fee is assessed on any student enrolled in a course with a paramedic technology course prefix (EMED). Chemistry Program – The program fee for chemistry programs is \$20 per credit hour. These fees support higher program costs related to laboratory courses and equipment. The Program Fee is assessed on any student enrolled in a course with a chemistry course prefix (CHEM). Natural Science/Biology Program - A program fee of \$20 per credit hour is assessed on any student enrolled in a course prefix (BIOL, EVRN, GEOL, NSCI, & PHYS).

⁴MTU –Upper division undergraduate students not enrolled in engineering or computer science who are enrolled for 12 to 18 credits will be assessed, based on their major, a plateau differential tuition rate of \$8,179.00 or \$8,354.00 (resident) / \$17,313.00 or \$17,472.00 (non-resident) per semester. The graduate resident and non-resident per credit rate for Applied Science Education, Peace Corps, OSM/VISTA, and National Service Graduate Fellowship is \$722.00 for students enrolled in engineering or computer sciences, \$637.00 otherwise, and the Research Only mode tuition rate is \$359.00 for students enrolled in engineering or computer sciences, \$317.00 otherwise. All International students are charged an additional \$250.00 fee per semester. Online courses are charged an additional \$38.00 per credit. Newly admitted international graduate students will be assessed an additional, one-time, \$100 international graduate student enrollment surcharge at the start of their first semester.
