Astronomy), Business (all), and Technology, Health Sciences, HPHP, Social Work = \$35/cr. hr. Nursing = \$60/cr. hr. All other courses (not covered above) = \$30/cr.hr. for UG. Online course fees are \$62.00/cr.hr.for all online courses. There is a Student Teaching fee of \$185.00 per class and New Student fee of 200. All General Fee and part of Program Fee have been rolling into Tuition Fee.

²FSU - Beginning in Fall 2018 U.S. and Canada non-residents students will pay the same rate as resident students for both undergraduate and graduate courses.

³GVSU - An additional \$28/cr. is assessed for International Studies, and Honors (course 200 level & above). An additional \$33/cr. is assessed for Dept Visual and Media Arts (Art, Photography, Film and Video), Dept of Music, Dance and Theatre, School of Computing, Allied Health, Health Information Management, Occupational Safety & Health, and Therapeutic Recreation. Paramedic Technology Program — The program fee for the paramedic technology program is \$45 per credit hour. These fees support higher program costs related to clinical and laboratory courses and equipment. The Program Fee is assessed on any student enrolled in a course with a paramedic technology course prefix (EMED). Chemistry Program — The program fee for chemistry programs is \$20 per credit hour. These fees support higher program costs related to laboratory courses and equipment. The Program Fee is assessed on any student enrolled in a course with a chemistry course prefix (CHEM). Natural Science/Biology Program - A program fee of \$20 per credit hour is assessed on any student enrolled in a course with a natural science course prefix(BIOL, EVRN, GEOL, NSCI, & PHYS).

⁵MTU –Upper division undergraduate students not enrolled in engineering or computer science who are enrolled for 12 to 18 credits will be assessed, based on their major, a plateau differential tuition rate of \$8,490.00 or \$8,671.00 (resident) / \$18,075.00 or \$18,241.00 (non-resident) per semester. The graduate resident and non-resident per credit rate for National Service Graduate Fellowship is \$766.00 for students enrolled in engineering or computer sciences, \$675.00 otherwise, and the Research Only mode tuition rate is \$377.00 for students enrolled in engineering or computer sciences, \$332.00 otherwise. All International students are charged an additional \$250.00 fee per semester. Online courses are charged an additional \$38.00 per credit. Newly admitted international graduate students will be assessed an additional, one-time, \$100 international graduate student enrollment surcharge at the start of their first semester.

6NMU − An additional \$250/semester technology fee is assessed to all Art and Design majors, an additional \$36/credit hour is assessed to all 300-499 level courses in Business and Clinical Sciences, 200-499 level courses in Nursing and all courses in Music except Music in Society, and an additional \$50/credit hour is assessed for all online courses. An additional \$68/credit hour is assessed to all Doctor of Nursing Practice program courses, and an additional \$10/semester is assessed to all Communication and Performance Studies majors. Other program specific fees include \$82/course for bowling and \$35/course for golf.

70U – Oakland University does not charge fees to its students; mandatory or non-mandatory. Graduate students are assessed a \$45 application charge, effective Fall 2017. Tuition represents the College of Arts & Sciences and the School of Education and Human Services undergraduate rates. The following schools have different rates: School of Business, Engineering and Computer Science, Nursing, and Health Sciences.
