

Internship for Credit through the Ferris State University College of Business

The College of Business Internship Program is administered through the Dean's Office. College of Business students in good academic standing and enrolled in either business undergraduate or graduate programs (ISIN) are eligible to apply for internship credit consistent with COB internship guidelines.

The College of Business highly encourages all students to take part in an internship, but does not require that credit be elected for students where an internship is not a graduation requirement.

To receive credit, the internship must be approved prior to the start of work.

Academic credit for internships must meet the following criteria:

- The internship is not supervised by a family member.
- The intern will complete a minimum of 80 hours of work for every hour of desired credit. *Please note: credit may be received for multiple internships if each opportunity presents new learning objectives. Please inquire with the Internship Programs Office to learn more.*
- The internship adheres to the US Fair Labor and Standards Act (FLSA) criteria.
- If the potential intern is seeking to complete an internship with a current employer, the student will be assigned new tasks/projects that will occupy most of the intern's time.
