


How to complete the Learning Plan


Step 2: Go to look up classes https://banner.ferris.edu:9000/pls/GOLD/bwckschd.p_disp_dyn_sched

Click to search for your term. For students arriving in August, choose the **Fall Semester.** For students arriving in January, choose the **Spring Term.**





Step 4: On your Learning Plan, make a list of classes which you'd like to take. This list will be forwarded to your adviser for class registration. This form will need to be signed by your adviser from your home university.


Please note: Classes at the 100 or 200 level will be open for all students. Classes at the 300+ level may require pre-requisite course work in that subject.
