Contest Rules

Contestants must:

- be enrolled in a secondary welding course.
- be sponsored and accompanied by a teacher, instructor, or assistant.
- complete and pass the written safety test with a 90% score or better.
- behave in a safe and reasonable manner.
- respect all people involved in the competition.
- perform all welds in the manner described in the weldment description sheet.
- online registration with payment will begin February 24, 2025, and end April 11, 2025
- bring all PPE and tools needed to compete in this competition.
- each high school/technical center may enter only one competitor in each of the five (5) welding categories.

Also:

- 1. Communication between student and instructor, once the competition begins, will not be allowed.
- 2. A \$25.00 per competitor registration fee is required. This payment is required at time of registration beginning February 24, 2025. No payments will be received the day of or after the competition.
- 3. There is no charge for one instructor. If you bring an additional instructor/assistant, there is a \$25 charge. You will receive automatic confirmation of registration via e-mail.
- 4. Welding equipment, weld joint configurations, consumables, and safety information will be sent on or around April 11, 2025, via e-mail.
- 5. No preliminary weldment drawings will be provided.
