- 1) background information concerning the overall workflow and its purposes,
- 2) hands-on practice using sample datasets and assignments, and
- 3) time for consultation and assistance with regard to data collection and reporting in your specific courses.

Participants are encouraged to bring a laptop and current course data (if available); desktop computers are also available in the workshop rooms. Faculty need not stay for the entire two hours – drop in as your schedules permit. *Light refreshments will be provided*.
