The Ferris MSCA student chapter again participated in two annual HEAT'S ON project in October, 2007. HEAT'S ON (Handicapped and Elderly Assistance To Service Our Neighbors) provides free home heating equipment tune-ups to elderly and disadvantaged home owners prior to the winter months. The home owners are provided with free smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, and if their furnace is found to be faulty and must be condemned, a new one is installed for them at no charge. Four students, Sam Marotta, Darren Cunningham, Alex Gasper and Adam Dukavas participated in HEATS On in Ann Arbor, where 72 homes were served. In the Big Rapids HEATS ON, Bruce Wenzlick, Neal Betts, Nick Schoendorf, Alex Gasper, Matthew Klok, Andrew Delonge, Jamie Ambeau, Robert Weideman, Tom Fath and John Jongekrijg pitched in and served 24 homes in the Mecosta/Osceola counties. Each year, students report that the activity is a "feel good" event, as they are able to help people that otherwise could not afford to have their furnace serviced. Sandy Miller, chapter advisor from Greater Michigan MSCA, organized the event and provides breakfast and lunch for the students.
