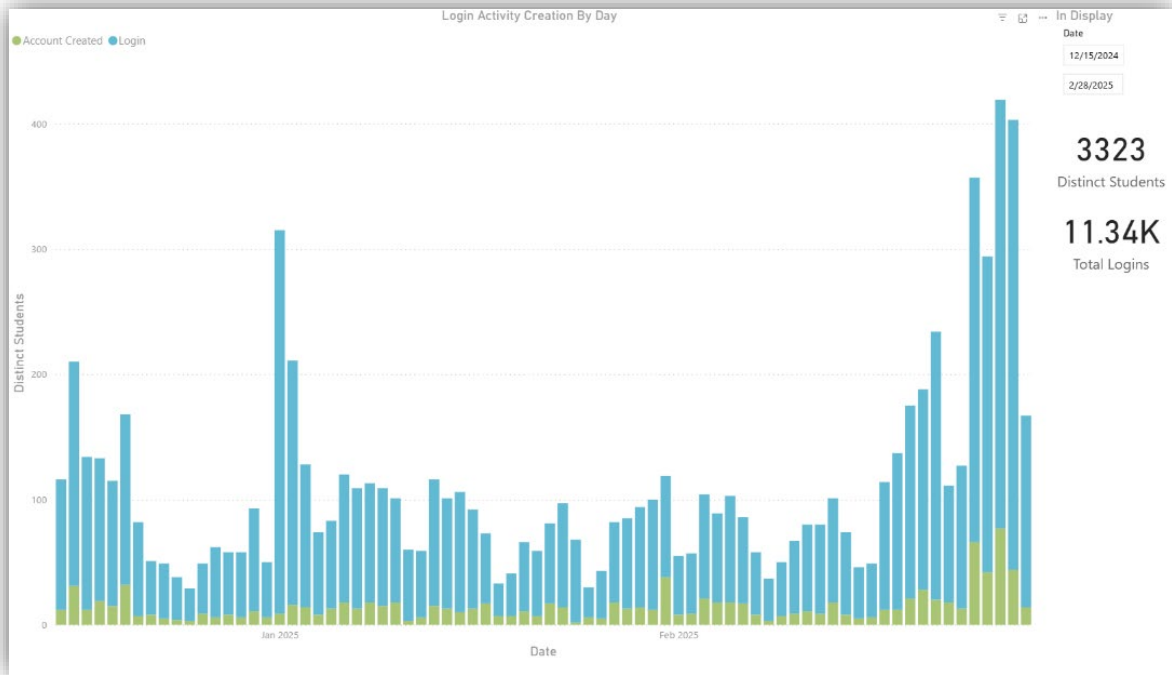
Students are completing remaining applications before the window closes tonight at midnight!

Important Dates to Remember

Review opens **March 6th** to begin exporting and sharing scholarship applications with committees to determine recipients for 25/26 award.



The Numbers Are In

For the **25-26** application cycle:

- 3,323 unique students logged into the system
- Average of 47 questions answered per student
- 4,160 total applications submitted
- The most applied-to scholarship had a total of 392 applicants, and 75 applications had 10 applicants or more
- Application-based scholarships had an 86% response rate

Get ready to award

March 6th marks the date that 25-26 scholarship candidates go to committee
