

Credit for Credential Agreement

Military Deployment Outside of United States

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the awarding of credit for individuals who have served in the military and have been stationed or deployed outside of the United States for a combined total of nine months or longer and are pursuing a degree from Ferris State University. Credits awarded through this agreement do not replace specific programmatic requirements.

This agreement applies to any individual who meets the conditions and requirements indicated below.

General Conditions & Requirements

1. Submit Ferris Application for Admission.
2. Student must provide a copy of their DD214 or other military related documents.
3. Student must have been deployed outside of the United States for a minimum of nine months.
4. Complete and submit an outline with examples for Culture, Self & Society and Diversity competencies. The outlines will be reviewed and evaluated by the Director of General Education using the Core Competency Rubrics.
5. Contact the Office of Transfer and Secondary School Partnerships at OTSSP@ferris.edu to complete this process.
