- Completed all qualifying courses for the clinical program with no repeats at time of application.
- Earned a minimum 3.50 GPA in all <u>qualifying courses</u> (see 2nd page of application).
- Declared the clinical concentration by the semester prior to the application cycle.
- Nursing and Dental Hygiene students must have completed at least 24 credit hours at Ferris State University.
- Radiography and Diagnostic Medical Sonography students must have completed at least 12 credit hours at Ferris State University.
