TRANSFER CREDIT POLICY

Purpose Statement

The purpose... The Transfer Credit Policy at Ferris State University (FSU) facilitates the acceptance and application of transfer credits to support students' progress toward degree completion. The policy encompasses credits from regionally accredited institutions, non-regionally accredited institutions, and American Council on Education (ACE)-recommended courses.

Policy

Ferris State University (FSU) including Kendall College of Art and Design (KCAD) accepts transfer credit from regionally accredited institutions when the coursework is deemed equivalent to an FSU or KCAD course or general transfer credit.

Transfer credits from non-regionally accredited institutions, foreign institutions, and institutions which grant credit for experiential learning and for non-traditional adult learner programs will be accepted when the coursework is deemed equivalent to an FSU or KCAD course or general transfer credit. FSU accepts coursework from non-regionally accredited institutions, foreign institutions and institutions which grant credit for experiential learning for non-traditional adult learner programs when deemed equivalent.

The Transfer Services Center (TSC) Office of Transfer and Secondary Partnerships coordinates, in consultation with the respective college, department and/or program to review all potential and current course equivalencies. Requests to have transfer credit fulfill requirements in a major, minor, concentration, or certificate are subject to the approval of the college, department or program.

Guidelines and procedures for the transfer of credit are located on the TSC and Kendall College of Art and Design websites.
